## # DAY 1 — THE BELIEVER'S SEAT OF AUTHORITY

### ### Main Scripture

Ephesians 2:6

"And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus."

### ### Supporting Scripture

Colossians 3:1

"If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God."

### ### Teaching

Authority in the Kingdom begins with position. Before a believer understands power, he must understand where he is seated.

Scripture reveals that the believer is seated **\*\*with Christ in heavenly places\*\***. This is not a poetic statement; it is a spiritual reality. When Jesus rose from the dead and ascended into heaven, the believer was included in that victory.

### ### Teaching
