****DAY 1 — THE REALITY OF A NEW START****

****Main Scripture****

****Isaiah 43:19****

"Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert."*

****Supporting Scripture****

****2 Corinthians 5:17****

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."*

Teaching

Every new season begins with God before it begins with man. A new start is not merely the turning of a calendar page; it is an opportunity to align with what God desires to establish in your life. God is a God of new beginnings. Throughout Scripture, whenever people surrendered to Him, He gave them a fresh start regardless of their past.

Supporting Scripture

Isaiah 43:18

"Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old."

Teaching

A new beginning requires an intentional departure from the old. God cannot fully establish you in a new season if your heart remains attached to the previous one. Every divine transition demands that something be left behind.

Many people desire new doors while refusing to release old habits, old mindsets, old relationships, and old disappointments. Yet God never pours new wine into old wineskins. The new requires room to grow.

Teaching
